Two Separate Trailing Trials in the “Heart of the Amish Country”
Lancaster, Pennsylvania**

**Saturday, September 18, 2010
and
Sunday, September 19, 2010**

Over the two (2) days, we will offer approximately 16 trails at various levels. EEC certifications will be offered only as time and personnel permit and should be pre-arranged by contacting Event Chair, Jim Heck (Telephone: 717-774-5281). Trails will be run from early morning to mid-afternoon at both the Greenfield Corporate Center and Lancaster County Central Park in Lancaster, PA.

Event headquarters will be at Clarion Inn Historic Strasburg Inn, 1400 Historic Drive, Strasburg, PA 17579. To make your hotel reservation, please call 717-687-7691 and be sure to ask for the block of rooms for the BLOODHOUND EVENT. **You will need to tell them if you will have a dog in the room with you** for the safety of their house-keeping staff. The room rate is \$90.00. **Well-behaved crated dogs are allowed in the rooms** and the hotel management has graciously offered to waive the pet fee.

Your hotel rate will include a continental breakfast. A box lunch on Saturday at the Greenfield Corporate Center will be available to everyone at a minimal cost of \$6.00 per person (excluding judges). The lunch on Sunday will be served at the Lancaster County Central Park (Pavilion #3) at the Lancaster County Central Park and will also be available at a minimal cost of \$6.00 per person, and yes – this will include Lancaster County’s traditional ‘chicken corn soup’.

Use the attached form to make reservations for the “Amish Classic Traditional Family Style Meal” on Saturday evening, September 18, 2010 at Hershey Farm Restaurant & Inn, located one (1) mile from the hotel site on Route 896. At 5:30 p.m. in the banquet room, the Colonial Bloodhound Club will conduct their ‘general membership’ meeting and everyone is welcome to attend. Following the meeting, a social time will begin at 6:00 p.m. and the meal will be served at 6:30 p.m. The menu will include:

Fried Chicken, tender roast beef, ham balls, real mashed potatoes, bread filling, green beans, buttered corn, sweet & sour relishes, homemade rolls, the area’s best shoo-fly pie, apple pie, and hand-dipped vanilla ice cream, fresh brewed sweetened/unsweetened iced tea and coffee for a total cost of \$25.00 per person.

Immediately following the meal, there will be an outstanding auction held of which the proceeds will be used to off-set the trailing trial expenses. Please be sure to bring some "interesting" auction items from your neck of the woods! This is very important!

We ALL need to "step-up to the plate" to help support trailing trial efforts in every way possible; i.e. entry fees, lunch orders, buffet dinner, auction items, and bids. Please attend the evening banquet in order to help support future trailing trials and to take advantage of being able to meet and talk with handlers from many parts of the country. Thank you!

Judges and some runners will need to be present Friday through Sunday. Please contact Allen or Patti Means regarding time of arrival and departure, as well as anything else we can do for you dedicated and hard-working bloodhound handlers! Judges are provided: hotel, meals, and fuel expense (please submit your gas receipts). For those judges who would possibly be testing on one of the two days, their expenses would include only one night's lodging and the buffet dinner. Runners will receive free lunches for the day(s) they are helping with the trailing trial.

Spectators are welcome at any and all events, so long as they do not interfere with the main focus, the trial itself. Because the trails are run at several different sites, the best way to negotiate the weekend would be to locate the "Bloodhound" meeting room at the hotel and show up by 7:00 a.m. on either day. The sites for these trials afford an unusual opportunity to watch the handler-dog teams in action. There should be ample opportunities to observe, ask questions, socialize, and pet bloodhounds. Your dogs on leash are welcome. Anyone wishing to accompany a handler who will be testing must first receive permission from that handler and the judges assigned to that particular test.

PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE BLOODHOUND OWNERS AND PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS – WE WANT TO BE ABLE TO RETURN TO THIS LOCATION FOR FUTURE EVENTS.
