SUBMISSION OF MATERIAL

Fee is \$12.00 each for the first submission, \$6.00 each for additional dog submissions thereafter. (When submitting multiple photographs per bloodhound-example: same bloodhound with multiple photographs- \$3.00 each-per additional photograph.)

DEADLINE for “Champions of the Heart” photographs & biography’s to be received is **October 8, 2010**. (Submissions will not be accepted at the event.)

BIOGRAPHY:

In your own words, preferably typed, per photograph submitted, tell us why your Bloodhound is the “Champion of your Heart”. Please limit your biography to what you can place on one 8.5X11 sheet of paper. Biography’s submitted via email are preferred in word document form.

Please include your Bloodhound(s) Registered Name, Call Name, & Date of Birth. Submissions for Bloodhounds of the past-please include Date of Death.

PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photographs submitted can be candid or professional.

Photographs submitted via U.S. Postal Service are preferred.

Photographs no larger than 8X10.

Each photograph must have dogs’ name, owners’ name, owners’ address, phone number & e-mail address on back of photograph prior to mailing.

Original photographs will be returned via U.S. Postal Service or upon conclusion at the event.

Photographs submitted in digital format are acceptable.

Please follow these guidelines:

In order to produce the best quality, acceptable file formats are JPEG. Images should be 600 X 525 pixels at 300 pixels per square inch, or 2-inches wide by 1.8-inches tall at 300dpi. JPEG images should be saved at high quality, low compression.

Photographs received in digital format will be printed on heavy grade laser paper and destroyed upon conclusion of the event or upon request of the owner will be returned to the owner at the event only and not returned via U.S. Postal Service.
