Equipment

Handler: appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear (hiking shoes/boots) for the weather. Optional: some handlers because their hound is so strong like to wear a pair of driving/athletic gloves.

Hound: harness, 25-30' lead, bottles of water, poop bags, treats, crate, and anything else that your hound needs when traveling.

Note: When not being worked, hounds must be contained in a crate. Dogs may NOT be tied out or staked.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the park.
